



NYC DOC Correctional Facilities in NYC and Riker's Island Kitchen/Cafeteria/Pantry Renovations, C-141 Quick-Serve Projects

As part of the ongoing facility infrastructure capital improvements program for its Riker's Island and NYC Borough correctional facilities, the New York City Department of Correction (NYCDOC) contracted AGCE as a sub-consultant, via DDC to upgrade the following facilities.

- Bronx House of Detention for Men
- Brooklyn Correctional Facility for Men
- Brooklyn House of Detention for Men
- Queens House of Detention for Men
- North Infirmery Command
- Correctional Institute for Men

For these facilities AGCE provided design and construction phase services to provide new larger commercial kitchens either by renovation of existing or providing entirely new kitchen buildings. New Pantries were created for each wing of the inmate cells on each floor. Upgrade/new electric services were designed along new emergency generators, electrical power for lighting, HVAC and fire alarm systems, security systems, intrusion alarm and panic button alarm systems, intercom, door position switch and annunciation systems, telephone and data systems.
