



NYC DOC North Infirmary Command (NIC), C141 Quick-Serve Project

As part of ongoing facility infrastructure capital improvement program for its Riker's Island and NYC borough facilities, the New York City Department of Correction (NYCDOC)/New York City Department of Design & Construction (NYCDDC) contracted AG as sub-consultant to upgrade 6 correctional facilities throughout NYC, including 2 in Riker's Island. The project cost was \$60M.

The North Infirmary Command, which used to be called the Riker's Island Infirmary, is used to house inmates requiring extreme protective custody, inmates with special health needs, mentally ill inmates, and inmates undergoing drug detoxification, as well as some regular inmate.

For all facilities, including the NIC, AG provided design and construction phase services to upgrade and/or replace electrical power, lighting, and fire alarm systems, security systems, intrusion alarm and panic button alarm systems, intercom, door position switch and annunciation systems, telephone and data systems. These projects also included professional kitchens.
