



NYCDPR HighBridge Park Bathhouse

Named after the High Bridge, the city's oldest standing bridge, Highbridge Park was assembled piecemeal between 1867 and the 1960s, with the bulk being acquired through condemnation from 1895 to 1901. In 1934 the Department of Parks obtained the majestic Highbridge Tower and the site of old High Bridge Reservoir.

The Highbridge Recreation Center and Pool have kept active New Yorkers busy since 1936, and several playgrounds and ballfields have been constructed throughout the park over the last century.

As part of the facility upgrade, AG provided MEP design services, including electrical upgrade, fire alarm system and plumbing renovations for the recreation center.
