

NYCDPR Hunters Point South Rezoning & Engineering Infrastructure

Hunter's Point South is an approximately 30-acre parcel of land located along the eastern shore of the East River in Long Island City, Queens, New York. It is bounded by 50th Avenue to the north, 2nd Street to the east, Newtown Creek to the south, and the East River to the west. The site was then being used for a water taxi landing, a tennis facility and a parking lot serving the tennis facility. The City transformed the underutilized site into a vibrant, sustainable and well-designed middle-income urban community with approximately 5,000-unit housing development and ground-floor retail amenities and community facility uses, including a school, and approximately 10 acres of park land, that also included a waterfront park.
