



NYCT Bowling Green Subway Station

In order to provide handicap accessibility for the 100 year-old Bowling Green Station, AG was selected as part of a team of engineers and architects for this high-profile project. Bowling Green Station (4th Avenue Lexington Avenue Line) - IRT is located in Manhattan, just steps away from the historic U.S. Customs House, Battery Park and the NYCT offices at 2 Broadway. It is one of the 100 stations within the transit system that has been designated as a "Key Station". This designation required that the station be upgraded to meet the guidelines set forth in the Americans with Disabilities Act Guidelines. Work involved the design of station improvements including the installation of two new elevators, platform and control area improvements, new offices, and modifications to the electrical and mechanical systems. Working closely with the Prime and NYCT staff, AG developed the design which allowed construction to progress efficiently while maintaining the high level of service demanded at this location.
