



DASNY Staten Island Supreme Courthouse

MEP/FP/IT design review

This new state-of-the-art facility houses the New York State Supreme Civil and Criminal Courts, lower Criminal Court and related agencies. The 154,000gsf structure houses the surrogate, supreme criminal, and supreme civil courthouse. Space includes 14 courtrooms and 660 spaces for parking. The facility was completed at a cost of \$230 million, and to passers-by, the imposing structure evokes a sense that one is in the presence of the "towers of justice." Building facades are precast concrete and glass fiber-reinforced concrete, with copper sheet cladding and architecturally exposed structural steel.

AG were the construction managers as a part of Jacobs team. In that capacity, AG was involved in the project from the very beginning, and followed it through until the construction was complete. AG was fully involved in the design of critical building systems and provided guidance to the Engineer of Record

AG reviewed all MEP and IT design documents (drawings and specs) for each of the four phases, 30%, 60%, 100%, and bid documents.
