

SUNY Stony Brook West Apartments Bldg J Full breadth of MEP/FP, comms + security design services

Building J is a new building located in the West Apartment complex on the Stony Brook University campus. Previously, the West Apartments consisted of nine residence halls. Building J expanded the capacity of the complex, while continuing the language of design, style, layout, amenities, and finishes of the existing residence halls in that cluster. The building included 176 beds in 30 apartments with four single bedrooms per apartment. Each unit contains a kitchen, two bathrooms and a common suite living and dining area. The residence facility further includes commons facilities such as a mail distribution center, laundry facilities, one telecommunications closet on each floor, and mechanical, telephone/ data, and electrical service rooms appropriate to the needs of the facility.

The building confirms to the current New York State Building Code, the NYS Energy Code, and applicable executive orders, and is certified for LEED Silver status.

AG provided HVAC, Electrical Power, Power for Lighting, Plumbing, Sprinkler, and Fire Alarm Systems design services. Additionally, AG's scope includes the design of empty raceways for the Communications/Telephone System and Security System, and all domestic hot water distribution lines throughout the facility.
